WELCOME TO JUNTENDO

ようこそ順天堂大学へ

Juntendo University is a comprehensive health university that offers integrated education across a wide range of fields related to human health, including medicine, health and sports science, nursing, physical therapy, radiological technology, medical laboratory science, clinical engineering, health data science, pharmacy, and international liberal arts.

The university's origin dates back to the year 1838 (Tenpō 9) in the late Edo period, when its founder, Taizen Satō, established “Wadajuku,” a school of Dutch medicine, in Yagenbori, Edo (present-day Higashi-Nihonbashi, Tokyo). This makes Juntendo University the oldest Western-style medical school in Japan that continues to this day.

During the Edo period, talented medical students from all over Japan gathered at Juntendo, where an open academic atmosphere free from cliques was fostered—a spirit that endures today. Juntendo University remains open to talented individuals from all backgrounds and continues to contribute to the advancement of society.

順天堂大学は、医学、スポーツ・健康科学、看護学、理学療法学、診療放射線学、臨床検査学、臨床工学、健康データサイエンス学、薬学など、人間の健康に関わる幅広い分野と、それらを支える国際教養学を総合的に学ぶことができる健康総合大学です。

大学の始まりは、江戸後期の1838(天保9)年、学祖・佐藤泰然が江戸・薬研堀(現在の東京都東日本橋)に開いたオランダ医学塾「和田塾」にまで遡ります。これが、順天堂大学が今に続く日本最古の西洋医学塾である所以です。

江戸時代の順天堂には日本全国から優れた医学生が集まり、学閥を作らないその学風は今も変わりません。順天堂大学は、優れた人材を広く受け入れ、社会の発展に貢献する開かれた大学です。

Hongo-Ochanomizu Campus 本郷・お茶の水キャンパス

Hongo is a town with a rich history. In the Edo period, many samurai residences were built here, and temples and shrines were located in various parts of the town. Elsewhere in the town, there were many houses of merchants and ordinary townspeople. Today, universities have been built on the sites of those former samurai residences, and Hongo has become an academic district in which many educational institutes gather. It is a very safe and highly livable town.

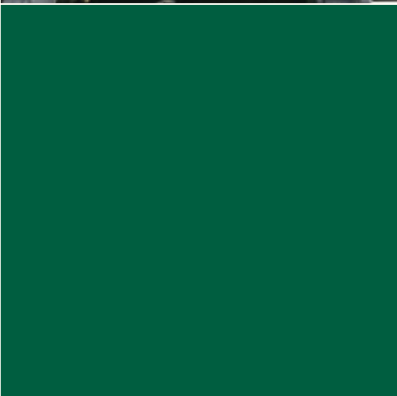
Located just five minutes by train from Tokyo Station, Ochanomizu is famous as the largest student district in Japan. With many antiquarian bookshops, musical instrument stores, sporting goods stores, cafés, and restaurants, the area attracts attention as a place where new culture is generated. Next door to Ochanomizu is the town of Akihabara, which is a hub for the communication of pop culture.

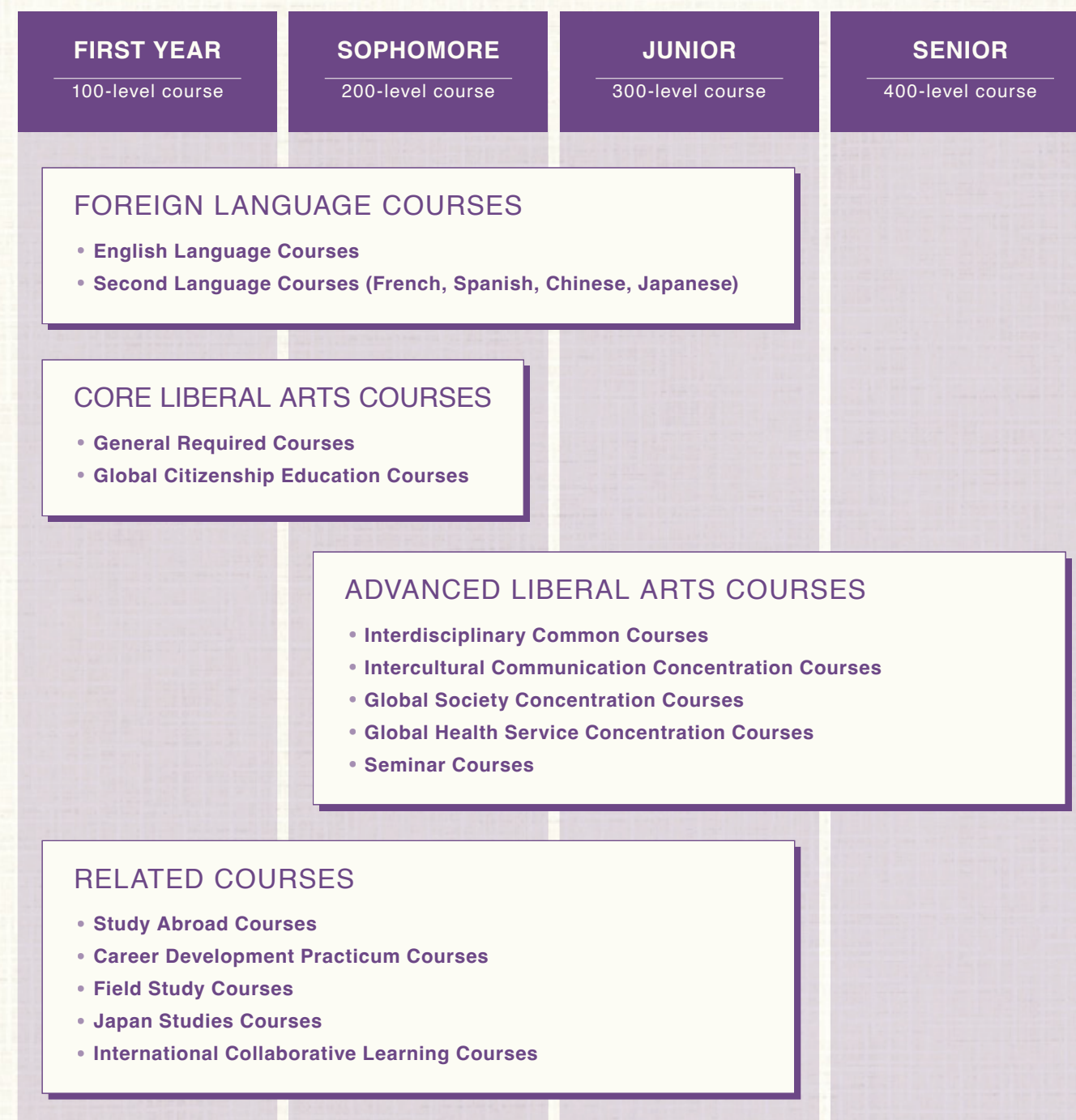


CURRICULUM FEATURES

カリキュラムの特徴

The Faculty of International Liberal Arts offers a multidisciplinary curriculum that integrates the humanities, social sciences, natural sciences, and health. Through interdisciplinary learning and practical experiences, students develop critical thinking, communication skills, and the ability to address global challenges.

ENGLISH TRACK

イングリッシュ・トラック

The English Track is a study track designed for students who demonstrate a specified level of English proficiency and meet the prescribed eligibility requirements. All required courses are offered in English, and by selecting elective courses taught in English, students can earn all credits required for graduation through English-medium instruction. Students may also choose selected courses taught in Japanese according to their academic interests and future career goals.

From ***Core Liberal Arts Courses***, such as Introduction to Liberal Arts and Liberal Arts Seminar, to ***Advanced Liberal Arts Courses***, including seminars and graduation research, students can pursue their studies consistently in English. In addition, through English language courses and second foreign language study, students develop advanced language proficiency while enhancing intercultural understanding and global competence in an international learning environment where Japanese and international students study together.

The English Track is available only to students who have been granted eligibility through the designated entrance examination process. Applicants wishing to enroll in the English Track should refer to the admission requirements and selection procedures for each entrance examination.

イングリッシュ・トラックは、一定の英語力を有し、所定の要件を満たした学生を対象とした履修モデルです。必修科目はすべて英語で開講され、選択科目では英語で開講される授業科目を履修することで、卒業に必要な単位を英語で修得することができます。また、興味や進路に応じて、日本語で開講される授業科目を選択して履修することも可能です。

国際教養概論やリベラルアーツ演習などの教養基盤科目から、ゼミナールや卒業研究を含む教養展開科目まで、一貫して英語で学ぶことができます。さらに、英語科目や第2外国語の履修を通じて高度な言語運用能力を養うとともに、日本人学生と留学生が共に学ぶ国際的な学修環境の中で、多文化理解と国際対応力を身につけます。

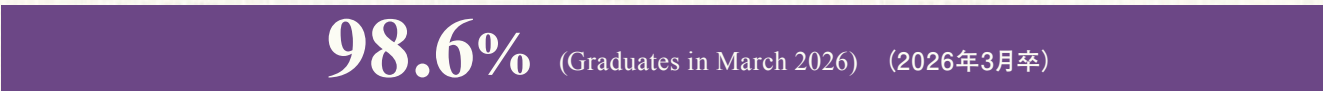

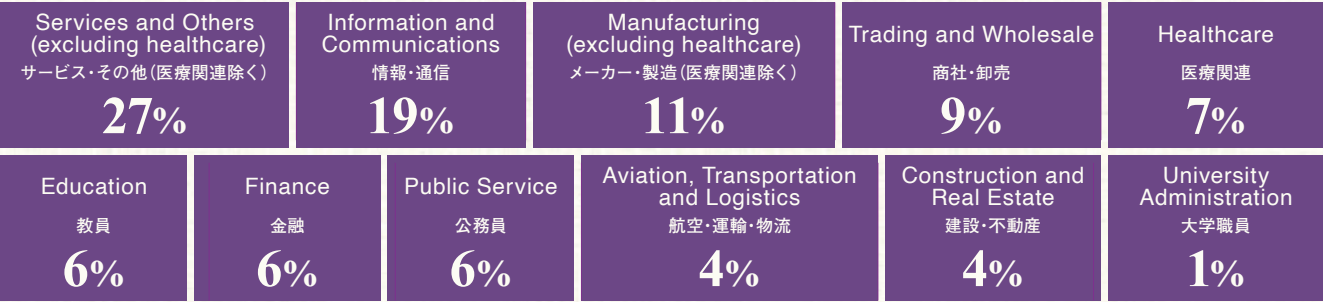

Admission Requirements 出願資格・要件

Applicants must demonstrate English language proficiency by submitting one of the following test scores.

次のいずれかの英語能力試験のスコアを提出してください。

- IELTS: 5.5 or above
- TOEFL iBT® (New Scale): 4.0 or above
- Duolingo English Test: 100 or above

Applicants whose first language is English, or who have completed the most recent six years of formal education in English while residing in a country or region where English is an official language, are exempt from submitting an English proficiency certificate, provided that appropriate documentation is submitted.

STUDENT VISA

留学ビザ

All admitted international students must obtain a Student Visa before entering Japan. After admission, applicants are required to submit the necessary documents for the Certificate of Eligibility (COE) application. Once the COE has been issued by the Immigration Services Agency of Japan, Juntendo University will send the electronic COE to the applicant. Applicants should then apply for a Student Visa at the Japanese embassy or consulate in their country or region by submitting the COE and other required documents.

ESTIMATED COSTS

Estimated Living Expenses 生活費の目安

The estimated cost of living is approximately ¥600,000 per semester or ¥1,200,000 per academic year. This estimate includes accommodation, food, transportation, textbooks, insurance, and other daily living expenses.

日本へ留学するすべての外国人学生は、渡日前に留学ビザを取得する必要があります。合格後、在留資格認定証明書 (Certificate of Eligibility: COE) 申請に必要な書類を大学へ提出していただきます。COEが出入国在留管理庁により交付されると、順天堂大学から電子COEを送付します。その後、電子COEおよびその他の必要書類を持参し、居住国・地域の日本国大使館または総領事館で留学ビザを申請してください。

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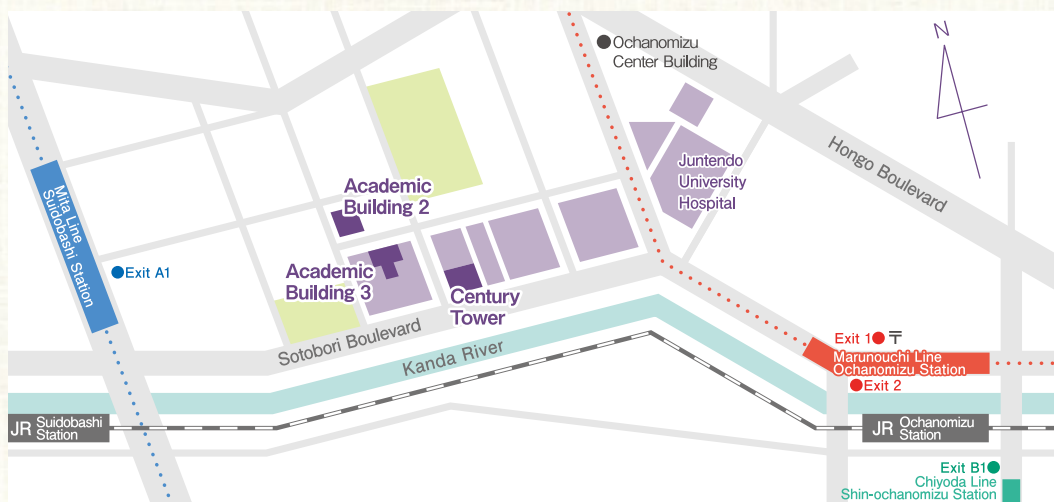

Ochanomizu Campus 御茶ノ水キャンパス

The Faculty of International Liberal Arts is located on Juntendo University's Ochanomizu Campus in the heart of Tokyo. Classes are primarily held in Buildings 2 and 3, with administrative offices located in Building 3.
